**VESSEL SAFETY AT JEBEL ALI CONTAINER TERMINAL**

The management at DP World has set out a strategy for improving safety performance in all area of our business and is committed to creating a safer workplace for our workforce and other people who visit our terminals. DP World has adopted a set of safety standards commonly known as the Fatal 5 to assist in managing these risks with our main goal of eradicating workplace fatalities.

Vessels visiting our terminals are defined as a temporary work area and due to variations in design, age, condition and presentation can present significant potential risk of accidents to dockworkers and ships crew alike. We believe that with the support of the Shipping lines and Vessel owners, it's possible to minimize these hazards to manageable levels to make the vessel a safer place to work.

Part of the strategy to be adopted is to undertake formal assessments of the workplace to identify potential hazards that can impact on the health and safety of the workforce and other personnel. The survey will cover all places of work and is to be conducted with a senior crew representative to ensure all parties are fully aware of any issues that may arise and safety concerns are addressed in a timely manner.

Following the completion of the onboard survey, the DP World appointed person will briefly discuss the findings and table any key areas of concern with the Master or Chief Officer. This could relate to the vessels design that compromises the provision for a safe working environment or a matter related to non-compliance issue. A formal report will be prepared and forwarded to the Shipping line representatives and where possible each report will be supported by photographs depicting the problem. The report provides a mechanism for the vessel owners to manage any rectification work required.

Local / International legislation, (IMO & ILO) place legal duties of responsibility on the vessel owners and DP World as employer. DP World seeks to work in partnership with all of our customers and would appreciate your full support in this process. The added benefit in reducing workplace hazards is an overall improvement in productivity.
