Marine Operations – Vessel Pilotage Procedure

In our continuous efforts to enhance our services and introducing advanced technologies in Port Operations, we are pleased to announce launching of PDA (Personal Digital Accessory), a wireless data communication device in our Marine Operations.

The device (PDA) is similar to Blackberry through which the Port Pilots shall be able to update pilotage activities for a vessel on real time basis directly into our backend system called PROMIS.

Implementation of this new electronic device shall replace the existing “Pilot Chit” which is prepared by the pilot and finally signed by the vessel’s master upon completion of piloting job. In the new process, the vessel’ master should sign digitally into PDA confirming his vessel’s pilotage job. These acknowledgements will be stored in DP World systems for future records.

In the view of above we kindly request all Vessel Operators to please advise their vessel masters to abide with new procedure.
